**WHAT TO EXPECT WHEN YOUR PET HAS AN ULTRASOUND**

We open at 8:00 AM and ask that pets are admitted to the animal clinic no later than 11:00AM. This will allow us time to prepare your pet for the doctor's arrival. Plan to spend approximately 10 minutes for admission. We do require a contact number where you can be reached if the specialist has any questions about your pet.

Your pet will be shaved. If your pet is being referred for a cardiac ultrasound, it will be shaved in its chest area. If your pet is having an abdominal or kidney ultrasound, it will be shaved from side to side. Sometimes it is necessary for the whole underside to be shaved.

Please do not feed your pet the morning of the ultrasound though water is fine. If you use food to medicate your pet, please use the minimal amount of food possible.

Often the pets who are referred for an ultrasound are not well. We take every effort to avoid sedatives or anesthesia for this reason. It is also imperative that the pet holds as still as possible. Sometimes it is necessary to sedate the pet in order to aid the veterinarian to make an accurate diagnosis.

A discharge time will be made for your pet's doctor to go over the results with you.
